

Your Health Coverage Tax Document Is Available Upon Request

Employers are **no longer required by the IRS to automatically provide the health coverage tax document Form 1095**. However, some states (CA, DC, NJ) still require a printed Form 1095 for state tax purposes. If you live in one of those states, you will continue to receive a mailed paper Form 1095.

Form 1095 is still available upon request.

How to access your Form 1095 or request a printed copy

1. Register at the [BenefitScape Employee Portal](#) by entering the company code **SegalACA**, your birthday (numeric month/day/four-digit year) and postal code (the first five digits of your home zip code).
2. After registering, you will receive an email from the BenefitScape Employee Portal (noreply@bencorpaca.com) directing you to create login credentials for site access.
3. Once registration and confirmation of your login credentials are complete, and the Form 1095 is produced, you can download it and print it for your records.

The [BenefitScape Employee Portal](#) also accepts requests for a paper Form 1095, which will be mailed within 30 days of your request.

Keep in mind that:

- If you have already registered on the [BenefitScape Employee Portal](#), your login credentials are still valid and you do not need to re-register. You will receive or may have already received an email from noreply@bencorpaca.com notifying you when your Form 1095 is available.
- If you would like to request a mailed paper Form 1095, you must make that request in the [BenefitScape Employee Portal](#) each time you need the form mailed to you.
- You do not need Form 1095 to file your federal tax return. However, you may use it as a reference when completing your return.
- The IRS may use information from the form to determine whether you or your family are eligible for the premium tax credit.
